Please note: Venue Loading Considerations emailed out to all Exhibitors below:

Vehicles and contents are the responsibility of the owner while on the loading dock. The loading or unloading of equipment is only permitted within the boundaries of the designated loading area as loading within the common areas of the building may impede or cause risk to others sharing the space.

Transferring Loads

- Flat-bed trolleys, scissor lifts, pallet jacks and boom lifts may be used – these should be provided by your freight forwarding contractor. The venue does not supply equipment to help load/unload.
- Pallet jacks must have urethane rubber wheels.
- Flooring protection materials must be laid on all carpeted areas to cover the entire track that will be taken by moving equipment
- Movement of materials through the concourse must be hand-held only and must also be registered in the move-in and move-out (MIMO) form.

Exhibitors must ensure the appropriate consignment notes and labels are completed and attached onto all their goods
